OUR NEW MEASURES FOR THE GYMS AT BISHOPSTOWN & CHURCHFIELD: PRE-BOOK YOUR GYM SESSION

- You will need to book in advance of attending the gym using our online booking system. Book your visit using either the LeisureWorld App available
- If you have any issues with booking on the app, please email info@leisureworldcork.com
- Please come to LeisureWorld ready for your workout
- Our changing areas are closed including our shower facilities & storage areas for bags
- Please note we will **not** be taking bookings through social media, it will all be done through the official app

Booking your Session

- There is a maximum number allowed in our buildings and the gym areas at any one time
- To help us manage this, all bookings need to be made in advance
- You can arrive at any time during the block you booked for a maximum of 90 minutes

GYM SET UP

- Social distancing will be implemented in the gym. Keep this in mind when selecting equipment to use
- Use hand sanitiser and wash hands regularly
- Our gym team will be carrying out regular hygiene checks and cleaning.
- Please play your part and wipe down equipment before & after personal use. We will have cleaning products available for you to clean all equipment.
- We have kept all equipment available in the gym to offer as much variety as possible
- Our gym team will be on hand to support and to answer any queries that you may have
- Please raise any concerns you may have immediately

- You will see that we have designated a number of sessions for swimming pool access
- Pools are only available to people aged 16 and over

WELCOME BACK TO LEISUREWORLD

- Following a review of our pool services, we have made some changes to our admission policy:
- 16- & 17-year olds will be able to use our pools without the need for an adult in the building. You need to first register with our reception team and once this has been completed, you will be able to use the app to book future sessions.
- 10-15 years old children can use the pool but must have an adult in the facility who must be located in the gallery area for the duration of the swim. The adult must be registered on our system. Children cannot book in through the app unless the adult accompanying them is going swimming themselves.
- Any child that is under 10 must still be accompanied by an adult in the
 water at all times. The child must be booked in as above and the Adult pre
 book themselves into the pool before they arrive.
- You can arrive at any point during that session
- You will be given a wristband & this will allow you 1 hour 15 minutes access
- You should maintain social distancing in all areas, especially corridors and changing areas
- Pre & Post rinse showers are available on entry & exit, but no hair washing or prolonged/private showers are allowed
- Lane swimming sessions will have various speed lanes, and you may be asked by the Lifeguard to move to a lane more suited to your swimming speed (if needed to help with social distancing)
- Family Swim bookings are for 4 (2 Adults / 2 Children or 1 Adult / 3 Children) Children under 4 are free, Children over 4 will be charged at entry, but parent should book in advance.

HOW TO BOOK

- Bookings can be made by downloading the LeisureWorld App
- **Pre-payment** is required on all pitch bookings
- Cancellation 6 hours or more before booking start time = Full refund
- Cancellation less than 6 hours before booking start time will incur a €10 fee.
- No Shows will be charged in full
- Note that the person booking will be the relevant contact in relation to COVID-19 contact tracing and is required to have the contact details for all players that attend.
