

Leisureworld Admission Policy

General Admission

- Admission to the Leisure Centre is subject to the applicable admission fees, either through membership or pay-as-you-go charges.
 - Members must scan their barcode or check in at reception to record their attendance and gain access to the facilities.
 - Access is based on the current timetable of activities, which is subject to change.
 - Admission to the Sauna and Steam Room is strictly restricted to persons aged **18 years and over**.
 - Adult gym sessions are open to **18 years and over**.
 - Student gym and swim sessions are open to those aged **16 years and over**.
 - Teen gym and swim sessions are available to those aged **13–15 years**.
 - All teens must complete a **gym safety induction** prior to using the gym or attending fitness classes.
 - All gym patrons must complete and sign a **Health Declaration** upon registration.
 - If you have, or suspect you may have, a medical condition that could interfere with safe exercise, you must seek advice from a relevant medical professional and follow that guidance before using any facility.
 - Pool use is subject to **maximum bather loads** for safety reasons. If capacity is reached, admission may be temporarily restricted.
 - Entry will be refused to anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
 - During swimming lessons a parent/guardian is required to remain **on site** for the duration of the lesson.
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Children's Admission

- Children under **10 years** must be accompanied **in the water** by a responsible adult (18+), at a ratio of **1 adult to a maximum of 2 children**.
 - Supervision from the viewing gallery or poolside is **not considered adequate** supervision.
 - Children aged **10–12 years** must have a responsible adult (18+) present **within the building**.
 - Children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times while in the centre.
 - Supervising adults must adhere to the required **safe supervision ratios** while children are in the pool.
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Conduct and Compliance

- All users must comply with the rules and guidelines displayed throughout the centre.
- These rules are in place to ensure that all visitors can enjoy a **safe, welcoming, and pleasant environment**.
- Any person who does not comply with this policy or who disregards the instructions of Management may be refused entry or asked to leave the premises.
